We believe that no kid should be left on the sidelines and all should be given the opportunity to experience the positive benefits of organized sports. KidSport[™] provides support to children in order to remove financial barriers that prevent them from playing organized sport.

How does KidSport help?

- KidSport provides grants to children from families facing financial barriers so they can participate in registered sport programs.
- KidSport supports programs that provide the child with a sustained sport experience led by qualified instructors. Note we do not fund City of Calgary Programs, they have their own fee assistance.

Who is eligible to receive a KidSport grant?

- Families that are on a low income, unemployed, on AISH, currently receiving income support through provincial government are all considered eligible.
- KidSport considers social and economic barriers facing the child's family when determining eligibility.
- Grants are for children under the age of 18 years. Youth 18 years of age must be attending high school to be considered.

What does a KidSport grant cover?

 KidSport Calgary provides financial support <u>up to</u> \$400 per child per calendar year (Jan.-Dec.) towards sport registration fees.

What are the funding arrangements?

 KidSport issues funds directly to the sport organization or community association on behalf of the child.

When is the deadline to apply?

- It's best to submit your application to KidSport as soon as you register your child in the sport program.
- Programs that are complete are not eligible for funding.
- Refunds for fees already paid by the family must be arranged separately with the sport club.

How to apply to KidSport:

- Application forms can be found on our website at <u>www.kidsport.ca/calgary</u> or at your local Calgary Co-op Customer Service Desk.
- 2. Find a sport program your child would like to join and register him/her.
- Complete the KidSport Calgary application form to request a grant towards registration fees or assistance with hockey equipment.
- 4. Mail, fax or email the completed application to KidSport Calgary.
- 5. Applications are reviewed by KidSport Calgary twice per month. Cheques for approved applications are mailed to the sport club within two weeks of the review date. Your family will receive a decision letter from KidSport Calgary by mail.
- 6. If your child is playing hockey in the Calgary Minor Hockey System apply for assistance with fees through the Flames Even Strength Program, applications found at **www.hockeycalgary.ca**

KidSport Calgary serves residents of Calgary, Airdrie, Chestermere, High River, and Cochrane (or within a 50km radius of Calgary city limits. Please note that Okotoks has it's own chapter.)
